

WITS "IT TO DIGITAL" PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT COURSES SUPPORTED BY BANKSETA FUNDING



The LINK Centre, located at the Tshimologong Digital Innovation Precinct, invites participation in its "IT to digital" professional development courses. The Bankseta has granted scholarships for more than 88 unemployed banking sector IT professionals and digital business practitioners. In recognition of its IT professional development programme, running since 2005, the Bankseta has awarded Wits University LINK Centre a grant for the 2017 academic year, to train and develop IT professionals for the banking sector.

The programme is aimed at professionals who aspire to develop their careers in digital innovation and leadership in banking. The programme gears participants to eventually fill senior and executive management roles in the digital innovation and IT space, roles which typically include IT Executive, IT Director, Chief Information Officer (CIO), Chief Technology Officer (CTO), or Chief Digital Officer (CDO), as well as professionals who work in IT functional teams, or any other business division. The courses are currently offered at the following three levels of professional development set out below.

Successful candidates, who graduate from the NQF level 8 programme with 65% or higher, are eligible to apply for formal graduate programmes at Masters level.
